The roundtable will gather representatives from public transport operators, eco-mobility startups, municipalities and NGOs, to debate about climate change mitigation options and the booming of sustainable and innovative urban mobility solutions. However, promoting such solutions requires both public and private investments.

Participants from public entities will discuss about ways, for cities, to support climate change mitigation actions. Opportunities for the private sector to tap into new markets through engaging in urban mobility will also be addressed, with a focus on emerging technologies to fulfil the future needs of the automotive sector and on improving public transports. Finally, the participants will be invited to give their vision on urban transport and ecomobility financing and their opinion and experiences with international investment mechanisms, with the objective to accelerate the transfer of low carbon disruptive technologies towards emerging and developing cities.
